At the same time, you will learn about non-violence, Personalism, the philosophy of the Catholic Worker, participate in a Retreat and you may take part in non-violent, social justice activity. Come and put your faith to work and expand your horizons. *(We offer two one-week programs in March. Room and board provided. Mar. 7-13 & Mar. 14-20; Positions are Limited; Applications due 2/15/2010)*

**Transformative Summer Internship-** June 1- Aug. 15, 2010

**Perform the Works of Mercy and Learn about the philosophy of Dorothy Day and Peter Maurin**

**S**pend a summer providing care to the hungry and needy. Participate in Clarification of Thought Seminars, learn about Personalism, Dorothy Day, Peter Maurin, Thomas Merton and Non-violence. Attend spiritually-directed retreats, hike to the Abbey on the Genesee in Piffard, NY, run by Trappist Monks. Learn how to help individuals navigate social service agencies. Help prepare and serve meals. Have an ecumenical experience by learning first-hand the teachings of Anabaptists, Catholic mysticism and Christian reformers. Visit the Rochester Zen Center and the Rochester Assisi Institute. Participate in non-violent, social justice and anti-war efforts. *(Free room and board; travel assistance if needed. Positions are limited. Applications due 5/1/2010)*

**Live-In Catholic Worker Staff Position** (1 to 2 Years; Two-Week Orientation Required)

**Serve as a full-time staff member**

**T**here isn't a better way to experience a Catholic Worker Community than serving as a full-time staff member. You will participate in all of the house events, *Clarifications of Thought* and social and spiritual activities. A commitment can be from one to two years. *(Room and board provided; weekly stipend, travel assistance if needed; health plan options; positions are available for 2009 through 2010.)*
